Highlights of 2022 are shared below:



3 Generations' short film, ***A Kaddish For Selim*** had its World Premiere on January 13th at the Walter Reade Theater at the Lincoln Center as an official selection of the 2022 New York Jewish Film Festival. It was also a selection of the Toronto Jewish Film Festival. It is directed and written by Jane Wells and edited by Francesco Portinari.

Our multiple-award-winning short film ***Preserving the Holocaust*** was screened at the Denver Jewish Film Festival and as part of the Kupferberg Holocaust Center's Yom HaShoah Commemoration.

Our award-winning, documentary feature ***Pot Luck***, became available to stream on TUBI.

Our local advocacy work included a short video about the **Ukrainian Village** in New York to show solidarity for the Ukrainians after the Russian invasion. A group of New York City high school students supported 3 Generations by holding a bake sale for **Climate Change** in Washington Square Park.

Celebrating the **Summer Solstice**, we invited our partner **Puma Quispé Ayni Relief Project** to perform a Livestream blessing of the planet from Chincero, Peru.

Preserving The Holocaust was an official selection of the **United Nations Association Film Festival**, which celebrates the power of international documentary films.

We held our **Second Annual Youth Video Contest** with over 150 entries from 7 different countries across the globe.

In celebration of World Peace Day, 3G's founder Jane Wells had the honor of traveling to Dharamsala, India to meet with **His Holiness The 14th Dalai Lama**.

3 Generations began principal shooting on location in the Netherlands for a feature documentary about **Gunter Demnig's Stolpersteine Project**.

Other notable activities for 2022 include: A live hosting of the Anyi Relief Fund's **June Solstice** blessing, led by shaman, Puma Quispè; Hosting a town hall on **Reproductive Justice**; Honoring Native American History by the creation of a short interview on **The Wounded Knee Massacre** of 1890 and our first-ever online **Trivia Night!** to raise funds for our ongoing work.

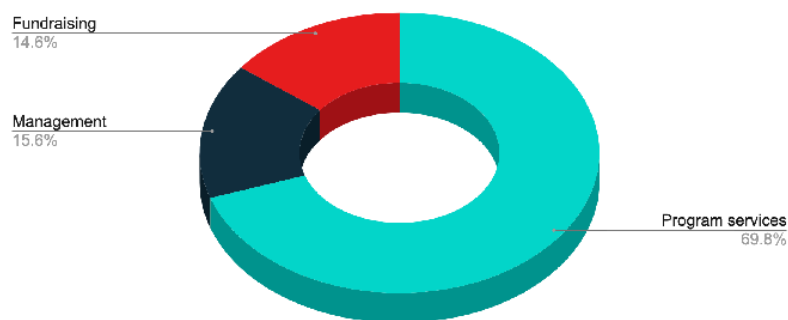

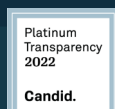
